Sub: Ease of Doing Business-Implementation of Reforms under State Business Reforms Action Plan 2024

Ref: Email dated 31.01.2024 from Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), GOI.

DPIIT, GOI has circulated the State Business Reform Action Plan (SBRAP) for the year 2024 for implementation in the States/UTs. The Action Plan consists of 344 Reform Points spread across following two parts, viz.,

- Part A with 57 reforms (Central Ministries/ Departments) and
- Part B with 287 reforms (States/UTs).

The implementation period of SBRAP 2024 is 1st February to 31st July 2024. These reforms will be evaluated by DPIIT based on the feedback provided by the service users followed by Ranking/Grading of the States/UTs.

While some of the proposed Reform Points have similar requirements as shared in previous assessment, new reforms are suggested to be implemented before end of May 2024 to ensure adequate user data for feedback who have perceived the services under the new reforms.

The comprehensive list of Reform Recommendations along with the Reform Points pertaining to your department are attached herewith for your kind perusal. Reforms suggested by DPIIT majorly covers development of online system for each of the services along with publishing of comprehensive list of documents required, fee, procedure with stage wise details and time for completion of each procedure/ step information on website, notification of service timelines under SAKALA and mandate to publish and regularly update the online dashboard. Also, DPIIT has informed to ensure minimum 200 authentic service users (as applicable) for each service for feedback purpose who have availed and experienced the services.

In the above context, kindly implement enclosed reforms as per recommended timeline and share the compliances/evidence to Karnataka Udyog Mitra and EoDB team. Additionally, a ToR to implement all EoDB initiatives effectively by departments is attached herewith for your kind reference.

The stakeholder department need to appoint a Single Point of Contact (SPOC) as EoDB Nodal Officer and for IT Coordination and to share the contact details by 26th February 2024 for the further ease of coordination.
