Ref:- The Chief General Manager (Ele), Operations, BESCOM, Bangalore. Circular No. CGM(OP)/DGM-OP3/AGM-OP1/BC-18/F-402/18-19/CYS-124 dated: 14-03-2019

The suggestions are made by the Government of India for improving the "Ease of doing the business" in the States. There is an assessment frame work for ranking the State in "Ease of doing the business" based on the implantation of suggestions made by the Gol. Karnataka Udyog Mitra, the nodal agency for Karnataka State has requested to adopt the suggestions made by Government of India to ensure that the Karnataka State is ranked on high in the comparison.

Adverting to the above and to expedite the existing procedure for obtaining new electricity connection, the following instructions are to be followed.

- 1. For collecting the number of mandatory documents required for obtaining the electricity connection in line with KERC regulations for arranging power supply to the HT/LT industrial consumers.
 - a. Proof of Identity of the user. (Adhar card, EPIC, Driving license, Passport, Pancard etc.,)
 - b. Proof of ownership of the premises or proof of occupancy with consent of owner, in the absence of such consent, indemnity bond as per Annex-8 of KERC regulations.
 - c. Authorization documents in case of firm or Company (Partnership deed in the case of a partnership firm, or Memorandum of Association & Articles of Association and Certificate of incorporation, in the case of a limited company/Limited liability Partnership firm).
- 2. The timelines for release of electricity connection for industrial use from the date of application, as follows.
 - a. Connections including CEIG approval (if required) up to 200KVA to be provided within Seven days, where no RoW is required.
 - b. Connections including CEIG approval (if required) up to 200KVA to be provided within fifteen days, where RoW is required.

Further, the above timelines will not be applicable for virgin territory i.e., locations where a new line needs to be laid beyond 500 meters from the nearest available source and where the requisition load is more than 200KVA.

All the Superintending Engineers, O&M Circles/EE's O&M Division are requested to adhere to the above mentioned instructions scrupulously.
